### KEY POINTS:

#### Christ Centered – The Power

1. Power and healing come only from \_\_\_\_\_.
2. Christian care is Christ centered and faith filled.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ on God to bring about the results He wants.
4. The key thing people need most is a loving, trusting relationship with God.

#### Love 'em like Jesus – The Face of Christ

1. Be Jesus with skin on, communicating God's grace as best you can and seize every opportunity to reveal God's grace to others.
2. The \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ you show demonstrates Christ's mercy and compassion.

*Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and **crowns you with love and compassion.** –Psalm 103:2-4*

*Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, **clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.** - Colossians 3:11*

#### God Provides the Cure – You provide the Care

1. Accept others with grace and as people who possess the same righteousness, grace, and mercy as God has given you.
2. Create \_\_\_\_\_ by providing a safe place where others can face the badness in their lives without damage to their self-respect.
3. Listen to others to understand their feelings, needs, and especially how they understand and relate to God
4. Concentrate on caring leave the \_\_\_\_\_ to God.
5. True freedom comes from trusting God.

*But those who look intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continue in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do. -James 1:25*

**KEY POINTS:**

### What does the Bible say about Conflict?

*Blessed are the Peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. –Matthew 5:9*

Also: James 4:1-3, 1 John 4:19-21, Matthew 5:23-24, Romans 12:18, and Ephesians 4:2-3

### What should your group know about conflict?

- It's a \_\_\_\_\_ of every group.

### 3 Types of Conflict

1. Extra Grace Required (personality)
  - a. This is when someone in the group needs much more care and attention than everyone else, or when two members just rub each other the wrong way.
2. Ideology (issue or methodology)
  - a. When LifeGroup members have different views and ideas about what the group should be about.
3. Sin Issue (character)
  - a. When a member is involved in a sin lifestyle or a destructive habit that is not leading the person to repentance.

### 3 Responses

1. Learn People Skills
  - a. Purposely seek out ways to improve you communication skills (books, conferences, friendships with those who have great people skills, etc.)
2. Learning to respond in love. Diversity, although challenging, makes a group stronger.
3. Use Matthew 18 as a Biblical model.

### How to handle difficult or critical people?

The natural inclination is to FIGHT or FLIGHT

1. This is the WRONG response!
  - a. *It is better to be criticized by a wise person than to be praised by a fool!*  
Ecclesiastes 7:5 NLT

2. The RIGHT response is to \_\_\_\_\_:

- a. Listen when their motive is to help not hurt.
- b. Listen when the person can help.

*If you listen to constructive criticism, you will be at home among the wise. If you reject criticism, you only harm yourself...Proverbs 15:31-32 NLT*

3. The RIGHT response is to \_\_\_\_\_:

- a. Answer when the person is missing information that would change their perception.
- b. Answer when the person is open to change.
- c. *The Ephraimites asked Gideon, 'Why have you treated us like this?...' And they criticized him sharply. But he answered them... Judges 8:1-2a*

4. The RIGHT response is to \_\_\_\_\_:

- a. Dismiss when the person is characterized by being overly critical.
- b. Dismiss when the person is emotionally unhealthy or wounded.

*Jesus replied, 'Every plant not planted by my heavenly Father will be rooted up, so ignore them. They are blind guides leading the blind...they will both fall into a ditch.' Matthew 15:13-14 NLT*

**We Can't Please All People, But We Can Please God.**

*For we speak as messengers who have been approved by God to be entrusted with the Good News. Our purpose is to please God, not people. 1 Thessalonians 2:4 NLT*

## BuildLife Conference – Delegate to Develop

### KEY POINTS:

#### The work is too important not to learn how to delegate.

*Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." –Matthew 9:35-38*

#### What happens when you choose not to delegate?

1. You rob someone else of the opportunity to step up and step in.
2. When you take on every thing you are on a fast track to burnout.
3. You create a culture of apathy and attract needy followers

#### How do you delegate?

1. Every time you commit to doing something new, decide what you're going to give away.

*Moses' father-in-law replied, "What you are doing is not good. You and these people who come to you will only wear yourselves out. The work is too heavy for you; **you cannot handle it alone**. -Exodus 18:17-18*

2. Delegate with the intent to Develop

God tells Moses how to empower Joshua: *Give him some of your authority so the whole Israelite community will obey him.* -Numbers 27:20

3. Believe in People
  - a. One of the greatest gifts you can give another human being is to believe in them. Who believed in you?

*We loved you so much that we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well.* 1 Thess 2:8
